Core becomes unresponsive, possibly because of database being locked

Description

I'm using Quassel 0.7.1, compiled myself from a Debian source package on my Debian Wheezy system (the new testing). I use a SQLite database for storage (libsqlite3 version 3.7.4). This is a multi-user Quasselcore installation.

I upgraded my Quasselcore to 0.7.1 about three weeks ago, and it has been running without problems. Today, around 03:15:00 tonight (last message I received in a busy channel), SQL query errors started appearing in my core.log. An info-level log is attached. The following error starts to appear:

This error appears for multiple queries, as can be seen in the logs. Seeing that this error occurs at 3 AM at night, and the core is usually used by about four people at the same time during the day, it seems unlikely that this is a multi-user issue. One of the IRC networks the Quasselcore had several connections to was unstable/down/whatever that night (other people couldn't connect either, but I wasn't there to get more information), and when someone tried to connect, he got no further than 'synchronising to core' (this is also in the logs at 07:15). I ran a quasselcore restart at around 17:54 the same day.

Setting priority to High because this makes the core unresponsive, requiring manual administrator access to 'fix'. Setting version to 0.7-pre, as 0.7.1 is not listed. If you have any tips for extra checks to add in case this happens again, I'll implement them in the current installation so the next additions to this bug report will be much more useful.

Happened again today (I noticed within five seconds). Log contains about the same. Looks like quassel-storage.sqlite is used by the same process a few times:

Maybe two of these file handles are accessed for queries at the same time. It's weird that this has only just started to happen. Maybe it's because the database is almost 700 MB; doing one update to that file might take long enough for another thread to start updating the database too, causing a race condition. But that's just speculation.

I encounter something similar - though I have no log file hence don't see that query personally. What I do see is the backtrace when attaching to a "hanging" quasselcore:
