**Description**

Steps:

1. Add "/setkey #channel foo" to network Commands to execute onconnect
2. Close Quassel and reopen it, then re-connect to the network

Results:

1. Plain text messages are sent in the channel

Expected results:

The encryption key is set correctly, and messages are encrypted
