| <p>When using multiple wait commands in the commands list for a network, it looks like it doesn't support multiple wait commands with the same timeout. If both commands use lets say /wait 5, only one is executed. When using different timeouts (wait 5 and wait 6) it works fine.</p> <p>No expert in c++ or Qt but the same key might be used to add the command.
