Thanks. I've tested with the following two URLs:

```
geo:37.786971,-122.399677
geo:37.786971,-122.399677?z=2
```

The first works fine, but the second doesn't fully capture the entire URL (it stops at the numbers). I'm still working to determine what we can do to get this working as expected.
