Description Steps to reproduce: 1. Open Quassel Client and connect to a Quassel Core. 2. Join several channels or open several chat buffers. 3. Rapidly switch between the buffers by clicking them repeatedly. 4. Continue switching for several seconds. Expected behavior: The client should remain responsive and switch between buffers normally. Actual behavior: The client may become temporarily unresponsive or freeze for several seconds.
