I have to say, that I don't really understand this BR. At first I thought that thouse "[INFO]" messages are some IRC-Feature, but they are obviously one information from ChatZilla. So let me try to break down the data you posted and how I interpret them:

"[INFO] Channel view for "#apache" opened."

Comment: this should be obvious. Imho not really needed as you have the regular join message and the topic and such things to identify your join.

--> YOU (ZRegis) have joined #apache

Comment: the join message itself

[INFO] Conference Mode is enabled for this view; joins, leaves, quits and nickname changes are hidden.
