**Description**

I have a custom chat list with "unread" channels (minimum activity: 'new message'). When there is new stuff in more than a channel in one network (like the famous moepnet), than if I click on one chatroom, the chatroom is correctly presented, but the focus of the tree-element is off by one. Like this:

moepnet:  
#something  
#news  
#paniks

clicking on #news

moepnet:  
#something  
#news  
[#paniks]
